OUR PROGRAMS

SISTERS LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT INITIATIVE (SLDI)

SLDI provides technology, administration and finance training so sisters can gain skills and confidence to become leaders in their congregations and communities.

HIGHER EDUCATION FOR SISTERS IN AFRICA (HESA)

Through partnerships with higher education institutions in Africa and the U.S., HESA gives African sisters the opportunity to obtain higher education credentials.

SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

ASEC provides scholarships to women religious to complete secondary school or certificates in Tanzania, Malawi and Zambia.

SERVICE LEARNING

ASEC organizes annual service trips for U.S. college students. Participants see first-hand how ASEC alumnae are transforming lives and strengthening the vitality of the African communities they serve.
